# LORD MAYORS CUP REGATTA

**NOTICE OF RACE**

## 1 Rules

The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions.

## 2 Eligibility and Entry

- The regatta is open to all Off The Beach dinghies, Multihulls, Trailer Sailors and Sports Boats.
- AS yardsticks for OTB Catamarans and dinghies will apply to Divisions 1, 2 and 3. The AS CBH handicap system will apply to Division four.
- Eligible boats may enter online [HERE](#) up until 10.00pm on Friday 27th August 2021.
- A late entry fee will apply to all entries received after midnight on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2021
  
- The race will be sailed in the following Divisions:
  - Division 1 - Junior
    - Sabot, Optimist, Bic, Laser 4.7 (under 16's)
  - Division 2 - Intermediate
    - Laser (Radial & Standard), Impulse, 125's, Flying 11, Heron, MG14, NS14, Pacer
  - Division 3 - High Performance
    - Skiffs, 49ers, Multihulls
  - Division 4 –Trailable Yachts & Sports Boats
- Sub Divisions may be created for any fleet of boats conforming to a single class with more than 5 starters.

## 5 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available from 9.00am on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> August at the clubhouse of the Brisbane Sailing Squadron

- 6 Regatta Site**  
The regatta site is the Brisbane Sailing Squadron, 128 Quay Street Bulimba.
- 7 Racing Area**  
The racing area will be on the Brisbane River between Hawthorne and The Gateway Bridge, Murarrie.
- 8 Courses**  
The course shall be as described in the sailing instructions.
- 9 Scoring**  
Results will be calculated using the 2020-21 AS Yardstick handicapping system.
- 10 Radio Communications**  
A boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats.
- 11 Prizes**  
Lord Mayors Cup trophy to the overall winner  
Prizes will be awarded to the boats finishing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each division.  
Trophies for the winners of each Division and individual classes for fleets greater than 5 boats
- 12 Disclaimer of Liability**  
Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 13 Safety**  
Personal flotation devices shall be worn at all times whilst afloat. Such devices shall be in good condition and in accordance with the specifications issued or approved by a national authority or standards organisation and branded in the country of origin or manufacture. ATTENTION IS DRAWN TO RRS Fundamental Rule 1.2.
- 14 Insurance**  
Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
- 15 Rights to use names and likeness**  
By participation in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for said event in which the competitor participated and in all material related to the said event without compensation.
- 16 Meals:**  
Lunch meals and snacks will be available at the Club from 11:00am on the day.  
Following racing a BBQ will be held at the clubhouse at a cost of \$10/adult and \$5/child.  
Participants are required to purchase tickets for their meal at the time of registration to assist with catering.  
The bar will be open from 10:00am for the purchase of drinks.

**17 Rigging areas:**

Dinghies can be rigged on the grassed areas in Vic Lucas Park to the north of the Club house. Trailer Sailors and Sports Boats shall be rigged and launched at the Colmslie Recreation Reserve and boat ramp.
